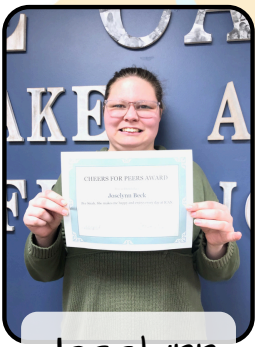
- Wednesday April 2nd- Wear blue for Autism Awareness Day

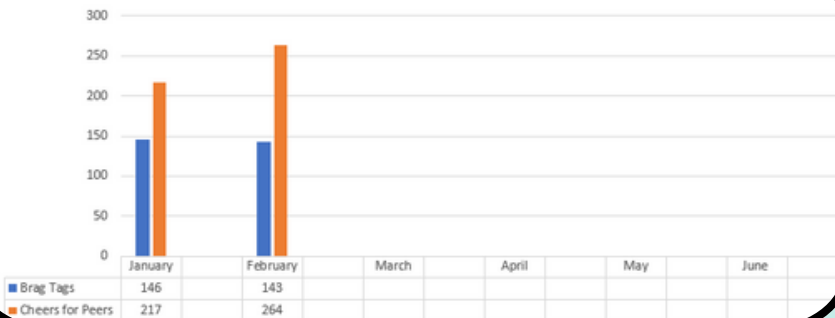
Outer Banks
